DOCUMENTATION OF SOLO PASSAGE

New entrants must document that they have made at least one nonstop singlehanded passage **under sail** on the boat being entered in the Lake Ontario 300 Solo Challenge, covering a distance of **not less** than 100 statute miles **AND** requiring a passage time of **not less** than 24 hours. If a different boat is used for the solo qualification passage, a complete description of the type of boat is to be provided to GLSS BOD or their appointees for consideration and approval. Entrants have until July 15, 2009 to complete their solo qualification passage. The GLSS and its appointees have the right to reject any entries for any reason that they deem sufficient.
