DOCUMENTATION OF SOLO PASSAGE

New entrants must document that they have made at least one nonstop singlehanded passage **under sail** on the boat being entered in the Challenge, covering a distance of **no less** than 100 statute miles **AND** requiring a passage time of **no less** than 24 hours. If a different boat is used for the solo qualification passage, a complete description of the type of boat is to be provided for GLSS Board of Directors consideration and approval. Entrants have until June 15, 2009(Pt. Huron & Chicago) or August 25th, 2009(Lake Erie) to complete and submit their documentation of solo qualification passage. The Race Committee has the right to reject any entries for any reason that the Race Committee deems sufficient.
