

# **Solo Scramble 2011**

## **Finishing Instruction:**

**In order to make it less congested at the finish line with other personal and pleasure watercraft, we have changed the finishing instructions to read:**

**A yacht shall finish by crossing a line drawn between the Michigan City Harbor Lighthouse at the end of the East Breakwall and Mark 0 of the Michigan City Yacht Club Racing buoys.**

**Mark 0 is located at 41' 45.20 and 86' 54.70.**

**The mark is a section of 10 inch White PVC pipe with red/orange lettering indicating its ownership and number. It stands approximately 5 feet out of the water. The distance between this buoy and the lighthouse is considerable....perhaps a mile and is almost in a due north/south direction. A boat shall finish by crossing this line in either direction and at any point on the line.**

**The intention for the change is to give the participating solo sailor more room to finish and put away his boat out of harbor wakes and congestion. This will allow boats that are looking to continue sailing in order to complete their 24 hour qualifier to continue sailing without having to dip in the harbor. In addition, it is hoped that the distance offshore will allow boats to finish in a more consistent wind than the sheltered area of the harbor.**

**Skippers are required to record their own time at the finish in GPS time and after docking, to be certain that the race committee has the correct time information. We will try to have a RC officer available on the radio to check in your finish and answer questions but it should not be assumed that they have taken your time.**
