Be sure to include:

- 1) Check for \$250 (\$230 for USS members, # _____) payable to TSRC.
Add a \$30 late fee payable to TSRC if the application will be received after June 29, 2007. No entries after July 14, 2007.
- 2) Check for \$75 payable to GLSS. Add \$20 late fee payable to GLSS if the application will be received after June 29, 2007. **Note - Entries received after June 29, 2007 may be rejected due to insufficient time to review qualifications. This fee covers the cost of a skipper's sweater with GLSS logo, and a commemorative medallion. See page three to make your selection.**
- 3) If you wish a polo shirt instead of a sweater, make the check payable to the GLSS for \$60.00; if you wish a sweater and a polo shirt, make the check payable to the GLSS for \$105.00. Additional sweaters are \$45.00 each, additional polos are \$30 each. Please include your size for each item. See page three.
- 4) Proof of liability insurance covering the period of the event.
- 5) Completed two page "Sailing Experience Resume" form. Not required for GLSS members.
- 6) Completed "Documentation of Solo Passage" form. This 100 mile/24 hour solo under sail must be completed before July 28, 2007 but still must be approved prior to acceptance into the Singlehanded Division. Not required for GLSS members.
- 7) Life raft inspection certification by an approved servicing agent within **40 months prior to the event** date. Note that this is a revision from the fully crewed Trans Superior requirement of 48 months. Also note that any multihull that wishes to substitute an anti-exposure suit for the life raft requirement must submit a completed "Anti-Exposure Suit Certificate" with their entry.
- 8) For monohulls: PHRF rating certificate from a recognized rating association. Note that some adjustments may be made due to the variance of rating associations on the Great Lakes. If no certificate is available submit a completed "Request for Singlehanded Rating" form.
- 9) For Multihulls: GLMRA (Great Lakes Multihull Rating Association) rating certificate. If no certificate is available submit a completed "Request for Singlehanded Rating" form.
